

Appropriation Transfers Report for January 2017

Per Section 2 - Appropriations of the FY2016-2017 Adopted Budget Ordinance, please find the following appropriation transfer(s) processed in January 2017 for the purpose of assuring the administering of programs authorized in the Budget Ordinance. The Ordinance states that such actions are to be reported to the Board at its next Board meeting and recorded in the minutes of that meeting. The appropriation transfers reports consist of:

- Transfers between departments; and/or
- 2. Transfers out of Non-Departmental Contingency; and/or
- Transfers for Departmental Special Gifts received.

During January 2017, one transfer occurred within the first category - Transfers between Departments; zero transfers occurred within the second category - Transfers out of Non-Departmental Contingency; and three transfers occurred within the third category - Non-Departmental Special Gifts Transfer.

Appropriation Transfer(s)

 The Tax Department receives a discounted rate for International Association of Assessing Officer (IAAO) certification and membership dues based on the large number of memberships it purchases. Due to this, Tax paid for dues for the MapForsyth GIS Analyst. This transfer moves funds from MapForsyth to Tax Administration to pay back the cost of one IAAO certification.
