The Ordinance states that such actions are to be reported to the Board at its next Board meeting and recorded in the minutes of that meeting. The appropriation transfers reports consist of:

During March 2017, one transfer occurred within the first category - Transfers between Departments; zero transfers occurred within the second category - Transfers out of Non-Departmental Contingency; and three transfers occurred within the third category - Non-Departmental Special Gifts Transfer.

Appropriation Transfer(s)

At its March 27, 2017 meeting, the Board of Commissioners approved a contract with Cansler Collaborative to do an
assessment of the various options available under the CHSA statutes allowing counties to consolidate human services
functions under a single entity. Budget and Management has some funds available for this contract but lacks \$13,050. This
transfer shifts \$13,050 from the Manager/BOCC budget to the Budget and Management budget to facilitate the execution of
the approved contract for services
