**RESOLUTION CONCURRING WITH A SMALL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT  
PROPOSED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 136-11.1, prior to any action by the Board of Transportation on a transportation project, the North Carolina Department of Transportation shall inform the county affected by the proposed project and request a written resolution expressing the county's view on the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Transportation and the Department of Transportation shall consider, but need not be bound by, the views of the affected county on each transportation project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation has informed the County of and requests a written resolution from Forsyth County expressing its views on the Department's plans to invest \$1,380,500 in a transportation project for the construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Hampton Road (SR 2999) and Frye Bridge Road (SR 2998); and

**WHEREAS**, it appears that this small transportation project will provide a high impact, low cost improvement to the affected area;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that it concurs with the plan of the North Carolina Department of Transportation to invest \$1,380,500 in a small transportation project to construct a roundabout at the intersection of Hampton Road (SR 2999) and Frye Bridge Road (SR 2998) for the enhancement of safety of those traveling through the area.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the North Carolina Department of Transportation is requested to involve property owners in the affected area in the planning for these improvements.
