RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DONATION OF SURPLUS, OBSOLETE, OR UNUSED COUNTY VEHICLES TO THE WINSTON-SALEM/FORSYTH COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF N.C.G.S. 160A-280 (GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT)

WHEREAS, Forsyth County owns the following five motor vehicles (hereinafter "Surplus Vehicles") which are surplus, obsolete, or unused and are therefore no longer economically beneficial to the County and should be declared surplus to the County's needs:

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 160A-280 allows counties to donate to another governmental unit any personal property that the Board of County Commissioners deems surplus, obsolete, or unused; and

WHEREAS, County staff recommends that the Surplus Vehicles be declared surplus, obsolete, or unused by the County and be donated to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education, a school administrative unit, which is a governmental unit as defined by N.C.G.S. 160A-274(a), to be used by the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools System; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners has caused a public notice of this proposed Resolution to be posted at least five days prior to the adoption of this Resolution approving the donation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the Surplus Vehicles are hereby declared to be surplus, obsolete, or unused by the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the donation by Forsyth County to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education of the Surplus Vehicles pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman or the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the necessary documents to convey title to the Surplus Vehicles by donation to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, on the conditions that said vehicles shall be used or disposed of and the proceeds thereof used by the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education solely to replace aging vehicles in the school system's active fleet and that the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education shall waive all rights to make any claims against Forsyth County relating to any failure of performance of the said donated vehicles, to which they

agree by accepting title to the vehicles, all subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, a public notice of this proposed donation was posted at least five days prior to the adoption of this Resolution approving the donation and this Resolution was adopted prior to donating the surplus, obsolete, or unused personal property.
