## RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND AMENDING CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES

WHEREAS the Forsyth County Board of County Commissioners approved a Resolution on October 4 for the purchase of various medical supplies by the Forsyth County Emergency Services department for the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for each item listed in the bidding document, with annual purchases from each vendor as follows:

WHEREAS Emergency Services inadvertently failed to implement purchasing of medical supplies from the required low bidder for each item and has mistakenly purchased a great majority of its medical supplies from Bound Tree Medical, LLC;

WHEREAS Emergency Services requests authority, going forward, to purchase each medical supply item from the low bidder set forth in the October 4 Resolution, with annual amounts adjusted to ratify the mistaken orders for items already received, as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that contracts for the purchase of medical supplies for the Forsyth County Emergency Services department are hereby amended to ratify purchases made prior to this date and to award contracts for the 2019 fiscal year to Southeastern Emergency Equipment Co. in the amount not to exceed \$77,483.80, Bound Tree Medical, LLC, in the amount not to exceed \$188,442.78, Henry Schein, Inc., in the amount not to exceed \$34,788.04, and to Medline Industries, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$14,952.51; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, contracts for the purchase of medical supplies for Forsyth County Emergency Services, as identified herein with Southeastern Emergency Equipment Co., Bound Tree Medical, LLC, Henry Schein, Inc., and Medline Industries, Inc., and subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are

hereby authorized to amend, on behalf of Forsyth County, such contracts as the need for different quantities of medical supplies arises, provided that no such amendment may exceed amounts budgeted for Emergency Services' purchase of medical supplies, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
