After Forsyth County was unable to negotiate a contract with Federal Engineering, Inc., due to the company not being authorized to conduct business in North Carolina, the Board of Commissioners approved a similar resolution selecting Black & Veatch Corporation on May 9, 2019. The cost of this contract was not to exceed \$248,674, split between FY19 and FY20.

Unfortunately, a contract with Black & Veatch Corporation could not be executed before June 30, 2019. The FY20 Budget includes \$90,510 for the next phase of this contract but the \$158,164 that was included in the FY19 Budget reverted back to the General Fund as of June 30, 2019.
