## FORSYTH COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA AMENDMENT TO 2019-2020 BUDGET ORDINANCE

FROM: BUDGET & MANAGEMENT MEETING DATE: February 27, 2020

## **EXPLANATION:**

Forsyth County has received \$122,795.39 in disaster assistance from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as reimbursement for Tropical Storm Michael-related response within Forsyth County in October 2018. This reimbursement represents 100 percent of eligible costs for debris removal, emergency protective measures, and restoration of infrastructure and facilities to pre-disaster condition.

Included in the \$122,795.39 reimbursement total is \$11,266.68 for Tropical Storm Michael response-related personnel and equipment costs incurred by Volunteer Fire Departments. This agenda item appropriates \$11,266.68 in funding for distribution to the following Volunteer Fire Departments:
