#### **EXPLANATION:**

This Budget Ordinance Amendment appropriates additional Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) Pandemic Funds to the Forsyth County Department of Social Services to match the State funding level.

The N.C. Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Social Services, has allocated \$577,959.25 in Pandemic LIEAP funding to Forsyth County to provide an annual vendor payment to

helpeligible households approved for automated LIEAP payments during this fiscal year by providing additional assistance toward their heating expenses. These funds are 100% Federal dollars with no County money involved. The Pandemic LIEAP payments are expected to be scheduled on December 11, 2020, and must be paid to the vendor within 30 days.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FORSYTH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021BUDGET ORDINANCE IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:
