RESOLUTION AUTHORIZNG EXECUTION OF A CONTRACTTO PROVIDE ELECTRONIC PAYMENT PROCESSING SERVICES INCLUDING CREDIT CARD, DEBIT CARD, AND ACH FOR TAX BILLS

(FORSYTH COUNTY TAX ADMINISTRATION)

WHEREAS the Forsyth County Tax Assessor/Collector utilizes an electronic payment processing service to facilitate payment of Forsyth County tax bills;

WHEREAS on October 16, 2020, the City/County Purchasing Department advertised for electronic payment processing services in the Winston-Salem Journal, on the City/County and State Purchasing websites, and issued bid invitations to a total of 48 businesses;

WHEREAS after due advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by the City/County Purchasing Department at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November10, 2020, in response to Forsyth County's Requests for Proposals (RFP) to identify electronic payment processing services for property taxes due to the County; and

WHEREAS terms of the bid specifications requested bidders to submit their qualifications, experience, results and pricing charged to taxpayers for electronic payment processing services, allowing the County the opportunity to select the bids that are in the best interests of the County and the summary of responses received are as follows:

WHEREAS following review and evaluation of the bids received, it is the recommendation of the County Manager, Tax Assessor/Collector, and the Purchasing Director that a contract be awarded to Point and Pay, LLC, dba Point & Pay effective February 1, 2021, and, unless sooner terminated by mutual consent or as hereinafter provided, shall be provided until January 31, 2024, provided that the County shall have the right to terminate this Agreement, without cause, upon 30 days' notice in writing to the other party, or upon 7 days written notice if the Provider breaches the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that a contract for electronic payment services for Forsyth County is hereby awarded to Point and Pay, LLC, dba Point & Pay, at no cost to the County and the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, a contract for electronic payment services with Point and Pay, LLC, dba Point & Pay for the Forsyth County Tax Administration, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
