SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

The Preventive Health Division of the Personal Health Services Administrative Service Area of the Forsyth County Department of Public Health is receiving an additional \$13,757 in grant funds from the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, Chronic Disease and Injury Section, Community and Clinical Connections for Prevention and Health Branch for the Department's Healthy Communities Program.

Healthy Communities program activities support the Department's efforts targeting the risk factors of physical inactivity, poor nutrition, tobacco use and unintentional injury. Additional funds for Healthy Communities will be used to offset staff salary and fringe benefits. New activities as a result in this increase in funding include:

- Promoting the NC Quitline service among clinicians and other health care providers, and
- Providing one additional training opportunity for staff and community partners on one of the following:
 - o Program evaluation and quality improvement,
 - o Health disparities and health equity, or
 - Evidence-based practices addressing chronic disease and related risk factors.

The additional \$13,757 in funding will support the Healthy Community program activities through May 31, 2015.
